

Who Was Julien Fleming?



Julien Fleming was a boy who lived in Sterling, Virginia in the 1990s. When he was three years old, he was diagnosed with a genetic neurological condition called GM1gangliosidiosis. The disease is so rare that it took his doctors nearly a year to diagnose it.

Once Julien was diagnosed, his mother, Donna, guit her job in order to care for him full time. The family had minimal medical benefits, and Julien's treatment cost over \$1,200 per month.

For the last three years of Julien's life, the major source of money for his medical care was from a few close friends and various fundraisers.

Julien passed away on November 29, 2000. He left this world peacefully, surrounded by his family.

In November 2002, the Julien Fleming Memorial Fund, Inc. was recognized officially as a 501(c)3 non-profit public charity to help other children in Julien's memory.
